

## DISASTER RELIEF AND SPECIAL PROJECTS- MOMS AGAINST POVERTY (MAP)

In addition to our regular projects, MAP has offered humanitarian and disaster relief in Iran since 2014. In the aftermath of such disasters, we've provided the following to affected communities.

### 2012 & 2014 Earthquake in Western Iran (Azarbaijan and Ilam Provinces):

- 10 tons of food, dry milk, hygiene products, clothing and other basic provisions
- 4 temporary Conex schools and school supplies for the children
- 300 winter jackets and shoes for children in the area
- Health care cost paid for 30 handicapped children

### 2013 Earthquake in Bushehr Province:

- Tons of food, dry milk, hygiene products, clothing, and other basic provisions

### 2016 Earthquake in Kermanshah Province:

- 15 tons of food, dry milk, hygiene products, clothing and other basic provisions
- 1,000 sets of warm clothing to hundreds of children in remote villages
- 150 heating and cooling units to families living in temporary shelters
- Hundreds of backpacks and school supplies to children in remote villages
- Four mobile Conex units equipped and mobilized as health clinics

### 2018 Fires in Village Preschools in Sistan and Baluchestan Province:

- 257 heaters with safety shut-off systems to preschools in six low-income counties
- 30 radiant heaters to 30 schools
- School supplies and 200 food packages to students
- 40 pairs of shoes to children of Zardin Kahir village

### 2019 country-wide flooding, with MAP purchasing and distributing supplies to the 10 most affected provinces (Golesta, Lorestan, Khuzestan, Fars, Bushehr, Kohgiluyeh and Boyer-Ahmad, South Khorasan, Chaharmahal and Bakhtiari, Qazvin, Kurdistan, Mazandaran, Ardabil, East Azarbaijan, Zanjan)

- 10,000+ packages of food, clothing, hygienic products
- 800 sets of home appliance to households
- Hundreds of rehabilitation equipment for the handicapped
- 2000+ backpacks and school supplies
- 2,000 winter jackets and shoes to vulnerable

MAP holds an OFAC license from the U.S. Treasury for humanitarian purposes and has been operating in Iran since 2010 through our sister NGO, Nikgaman Jamshid.

Since 2010, about 357,000 children have received food, shelter, education, and health care through MAP's work in Iran. During this time, we've:

- Constructed 36 schools, 2 medical centers, 2 libraries, 1 orphanage, and 1 cultural and vocational training center.
- Renovated and equipped 82 village schools, 30 libraries, and 30 orphanages and rehabilitation centers for special needs children.
- Provided emergency relief for thousands of children and families affected by devastating natural disasters like earthquakes and floods.
- Supported thousands of orphaned, disabled and disadvantaged children under the care of social services in Iran.
- Established and currently operate a private orphanage (Golha).

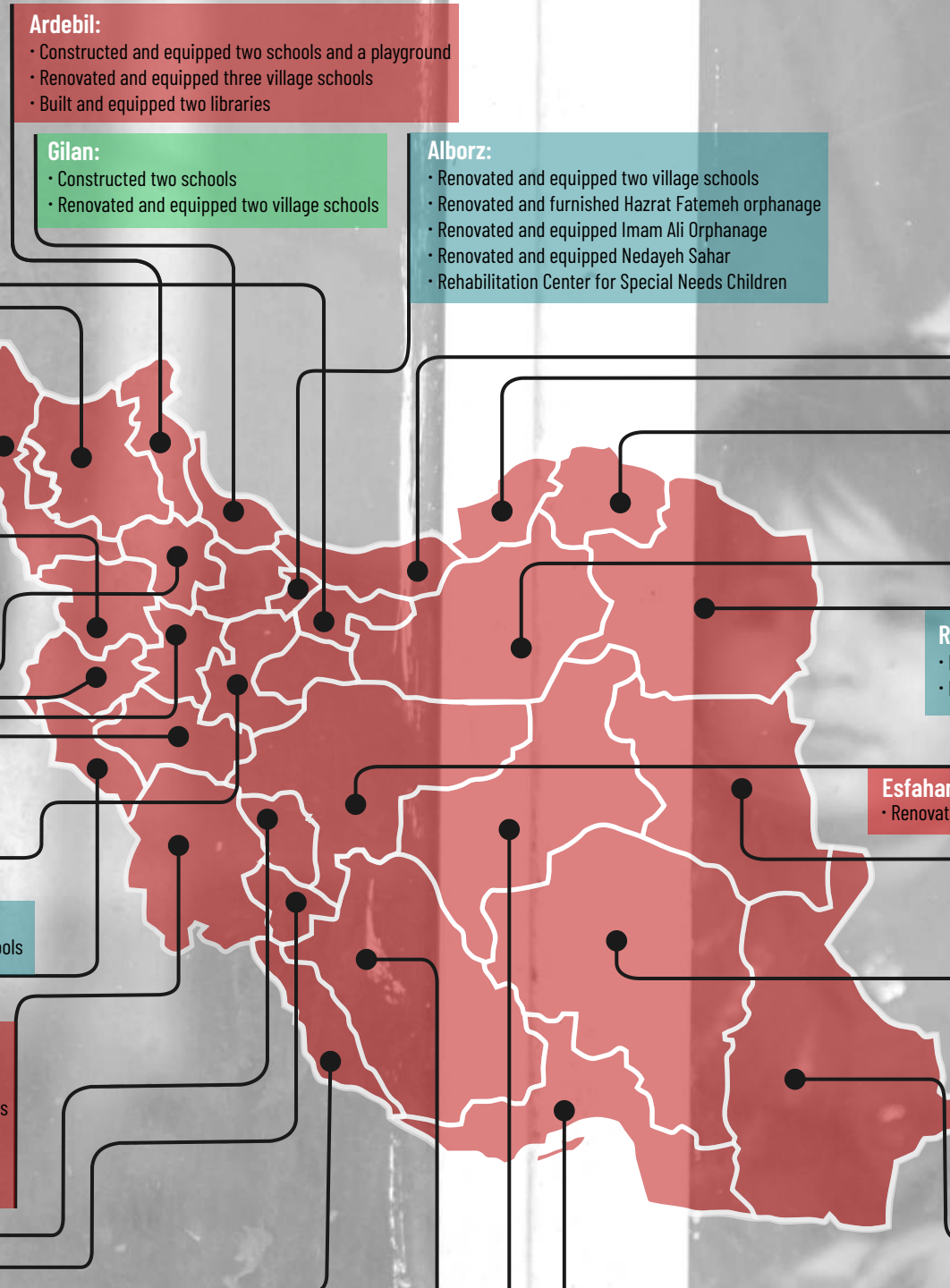

**MAP** has been serving impoverished children in various provinces of Iran since 2010. Our programs include supporting, renovating, equipping, and building schools, orphanages, and libraries. Additionally, MAP provides disaster and humanitarian relief to the children in need.



**Tehran:**
